CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT AND CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE

INSTRUCTIONS

At the bottom of each session page under Continuing Education Credit, all attendees must click one of following two options to verify their attendance in a session:

- I am requesting continuing education credits for this session
 - If you select this option, you must provide the Session Key provided by the session presenter (HINT: It is a number). You will not receive credits for any session unless you provide the accurate Session Key for that presentation.
- I am not requesting any type of credit for this session

After selecting any of the options, you must click on the "Submit" button.

The following Continuing Education Credits have been approved for the conference:

- **Attorney CLE Credits:**
 - The Tennessee Commission on CLE & Specialization has approved 8.50 general hours and 4.50 dual hours for a total of 13.0 possible hours.
 - The three sessions approved for dual hours are: **Ethical Infrastructure in Case Management; Decorum in the Court III (Part I); Decorum in the Court III (Part II)**. Prior to submitting your credits to the Bar, the IWCF will email you verification of your credits for your confirmation. Completion of an affidavit is not necessary this year, due to having a session tracking system in place.
- **Rule 31 Mediation Credits:**
 - The Tennessee Alternative Dispute Resolution Commission (ADR) approved 9.0 general hours, 2.0 mediation issues hours and 1.0 mediation ethics hours. The two sessions approved for issues and ethics hours are: **Decorum in the Court III (Part I); Decorum in the Court III (Part II)**. Those seeking mediation credit will be issued an affidavit and session checklist to complete and return to the IWCF, who will submit requested credits to the ADR Commission.
- **Tennessee Department of Insurance and Commerce Credits:**
 - 13.0 property and casualty hours are approved for adjusters and producers licensed in the state of Tennessee. Prior to submitting your credits to the Department of Insurance and Commerce, the IWCF will email you verification of your credits for your confirmation.
- **Rehabilitation Professionals – CCM, CRC, AND CDMS:**
 - CCM, CRC and CDMS have each approved 11.50 general credits hours & 1.50 ethics hours. The session approved for ethics is: **Ethical Infrastructure in Case Management**. Post conference, the IWCF will send you a certificate of attendance, so you may submit your credits earned.
- **SOCIETY FOR HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT (SHRM):** SHRM approved 13.0 PDC hours. Post conference, the IWCF will send you a SHRM certificate of attendance, so you may submit your credits earned.
