To get started:

STEP 1 -

From a *computer* – go to https://whova.com/portal/webapp/nothi_202008/
OR

From a mobile device - Download the Whova App

Search "Whova" in the App Store on your iPhone or in Google Play on your Android phone.

TROUBLESHOOTING YOUR CONNECTION: If you encounter a blank screen when you access the Conference Platform on Whova, try using a different browser. Whova recommends Chrome or Firefox.

STEP 2 – If you already have a Whova account, enter the email address you provided for Conference registration, which has already been uploaded into the platform. You must use this same email to log in for the sessions and receive continuing education credits and subsequent conference announcements, etc. if you do not have a Whova account yet, then first create an account using your conference email address.

STEP 3 - Create a password and type in your name. Be sure to keep a record of your password, which the event organizers will not have.

STEP 4 - Edit your profile. Please use your full name. Other attendees will use it to network with you.

STEP 5 – Sign in to the North Carolina Conference website. (If you have used Whova for other events, you may also see them listed.)
